



## Practical Nursing Student Program Completion and NCLEX Statistics

### Program Outcome 1: NCLEX pass rate

The pass rate for first-time test-takers is at 80% or higher for the nursing program.

### Program Outcome #2: Program Completion Rates

The program completion rate is set per cohort and is aggregated into on-time completion, 100% completion. The PN program is 2 semesters, fall start only. The 150% completion would be PN students completing the program in 3 semesters.
