



Phlebotomy Program Student Planner

Phlebotomy program applicants should be aware that program class sizes are limited, which may delay acceptance into the program. However, classes are offered every 8 weeks in fall, spring and summer semesters (5 sessions per year).

You may start in any 8-week session but must follow the course guide sheet posted on the LSC website by taking courses in the correct order, as listed. You must earn a “C” or better in each course to earn the certificate.

You cannot take all phlebotomy courses in the same 8-week session. The internship is scheduled by your instructor, individually for each person.
